The school year begins Monday, August 16th and ends Monday May 24th for students. The High School graduation will be Sunday, May 22nd. The High School will host an abbreviated conference schedule and host a curriculum night in the spring. Conferences will be held on a Thursday, November 4th and Friday in November 5th
 - 4. Fulton High School Boiler project update CTS is still collecting and determining bid prices for the work. They will provide a full detailed contract with pricing in early February. We will begin the bond cycle at our February or March Board meeting
 - 5. RISE (Rural Illinois Shared Education) software grant FHS, Sauk and ROE 47 are investigating the use of classroom web camera software that will allow FHS to have dedicated space with web cameras and software to connect to Sauk and other colleges that partner with RISE. Through a USDA grant all but 15% of the cost of the training, connectivity, software and hardware is covered. A full classroom costs about \$8800 dollars and a remote classroom set up is \$5500 dollars. RISE representatives believe the grant window will open in February. Those approved to purchase the materials have three years to get courses onboard.

We might be able to use CARES grant funds to purchase the buses we own as they keep out route numbers lower
