

This scholarship was established in March 2015 by Steven and Laurie Bruggenwirth in loving memory of their daughter, Brooke. Brooke, although she was only five when she passed, impacted the community deeply. The objective of this scholarship is to honor her life through the continued gift of giving back.

The Brooke Bruggenwirth Memorial Fund offers two \$1000 scholarships (non-renewing) to graduating seniors planning to further their education beyond high school.

The scholarships are as follows:

- 1. One scholarship for a male high school student planning to enter college
- 2. One scholarship for a female high school student planning to enter college

Eligibility

- A. Entrants must be a Fulton High School graduating senior
- B. Entrants must participate in the Fulton Steamer Basketball athletic program in their senior year
- C. Entrants must have an accumulative grade point average of 2.0 or higher
- D. Entrants must demonstrate good character (honest, kind, and a positive influence on others)

Entry Requirements

A. A completed application returned to the Fulton High School guidance office by April 15th, 2019

Administrative/Award Procedures

- A. Scholarship winners must begin studies within one year of graduation from high school or may be required to forfeit the award in the absence of extenuating circumstance
- B. Scholarship funds may be held until written verification is received from the college or vocational school registrar where the student is enrolled. At that time, the winner's share will be made payable to the winner
- C. Funds are to be used only for tuition, room and board, books and educational supplies

Authority

A. The Bruggenwirth family has ultimate authority to amend any of the above rules to ensure fairness in the award of the scholarships

Judging

A. Judges will be selected by the Bruggenwirth family. Results will be tabulated by school board administrators and declared. All decisions are final. Winners will be announced at the Spring Awards Night
