FAQ Dual Credit

What is Dual Credit?

Dual credit means a qualified high school student is enrolled in college level courses and is receiving both high school and college credit for the course/s.

Who qualifies for Dual Credit?

Any current high school student within our district who is at least 16 years of age, through sophomore level in high school and has met any course requirements.

How do students meet Dual Credit course requirements?
SVCC uses ACT, SAT and SVCC placement scores along with high school math credits to satisfy requirements.

Cost of Dual Credit with a Sauk instructor

 High school students are charged a percentage of the SVCC current tuition, based on their federal lunch code when enrolled in SVCC courses

Prices reflect the 2020-21 Academic Year

- Regular lunch students are charged 75% tuition \$113.25 a credit hour
- Reduced lunch students are charged 50% tuition \$75.50 a credit hour
- Free lunch students are charged 25% tuition \$37.75 a credit hour

The discount does not apply to fees or books

Cost of Dual Credit when taught by High School teacher

In order to provide accessible college credit to high school students, SVCC offers dual credit at a reduced tuition and Student Support Fee rate for dual credit classes that are taught by high school faculty. Regarding tuition, all students will be charged \$50 flat rate per class in which they are enrolled in courses in their own district with their own faculty member.

Payment



Steps to enrollment

- 4. Complete the online dual credit registration form svcc.edu/dual-credit-registration
- 5. Pay tuition and fees
- 6. Complete New Student orientation-if needed
- 7. Get the items you need for class

Records


Students must request and sign for their own records.

Withdrawing from courses


- 1. The student should discuss the withdrawal with his or her high school counselor
- 2. If the student then wishes to proceed, the online drop slip should then be completed.
 - Simply not attending class does not mean you've been withdrawn. A bill is still generated and you may receive a grade.
 - Students can view registration in SOAR account to make sure they are registered properly.


