

Quarantines/Close Contacts - Remaining Positive!

- Fully vaccinated (2 weeks after final dose) students/staff do not need to quarantine
- If there is a silver lining to the mask mandate, it's the test-to-stay strategy is now available to keep our students in school and playing sports.
- Students within 3ft of a positive COVID case can take rapid tests on days 1, 3, 5, and 7. As long as the rapid test is negative, students can stay in school and participate in extracurricular activities. Last year, students missing school and sports was the most frustrating part of the quarantine process. As long as all students are wearing masks correctly, kids have the opportunity to stay in school and participate.
